

## Proclamation

WHEREAS, experts agree that nutrition status is a direct measure of health and that good nutrition can keep people healthy and out of healthcare institutions; and

**WHEREAS,** inadequate or unbalanced nutrition, known as malnutrition, is prevalent in many groups, including vulnerable populations such as hospitalized patients, minority populations, and populations with limited resources; and

WHEREAS, disease related malnutrition is a highly prevalent form of malnutrition; and

WHEREAS, malnourished patients have hospital stays that are two times longer than those patients with no malnutrition; and

**WHEREAS,** Malnutrition Awareness Week is an annual campaign aimed at increasing awareness about malnutrition, its impact, and the importance of early detection and treatment.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Katie Hobbs, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim September 8 - 12, 2025, as,
