For your abstract submission, please use the following terms and abbreviations for your content. Using these terms and abbreviations for written documents/slides is consistent with the style convention and abbreviations in the ASPEN definitions document with the exception of adding the olive and soy-ILE product and revising the soy, MCT, olive and fish ILE abbreviation from SMOF-ILE to include the O's for oil. The generic term and abbreviation below are acceptable to use, the product name is NOT acceptable to use.
